Submitting **in time has a big advantage** at the Agile Tour Vienna. If you submit by **14 April**, you will receive **valuable and constructive feedback from our review team** and have the opportunity to **adapt your abstract** accordingly.

The Review Team will finish the selection of talks for the "Young Talents" track by the end of April, and for the main track by beginning of June. Everyone who submitted a proposal will be informed once the decision is final. Speakers will receive a free ticket for the Agile Tour Vienna 2024. The Agile Tour Vienna is a non-profit community event which aims to keep ticket prices low. Therefore it is not possible to cover travel expenses or pay a speaking fee.

There is a specific set of requirements for submissions for this track:

- You are under 30 years old
- This is your first presentation at a conference
- Your session is a classic talk or practitioner report

Young talents will receive additional support.

 - \rightarrow Individual coaching to prepare you for your talk
 - \rightarrow Option to hold a rehearsal in front of a small audience providing you with valuable feedback
