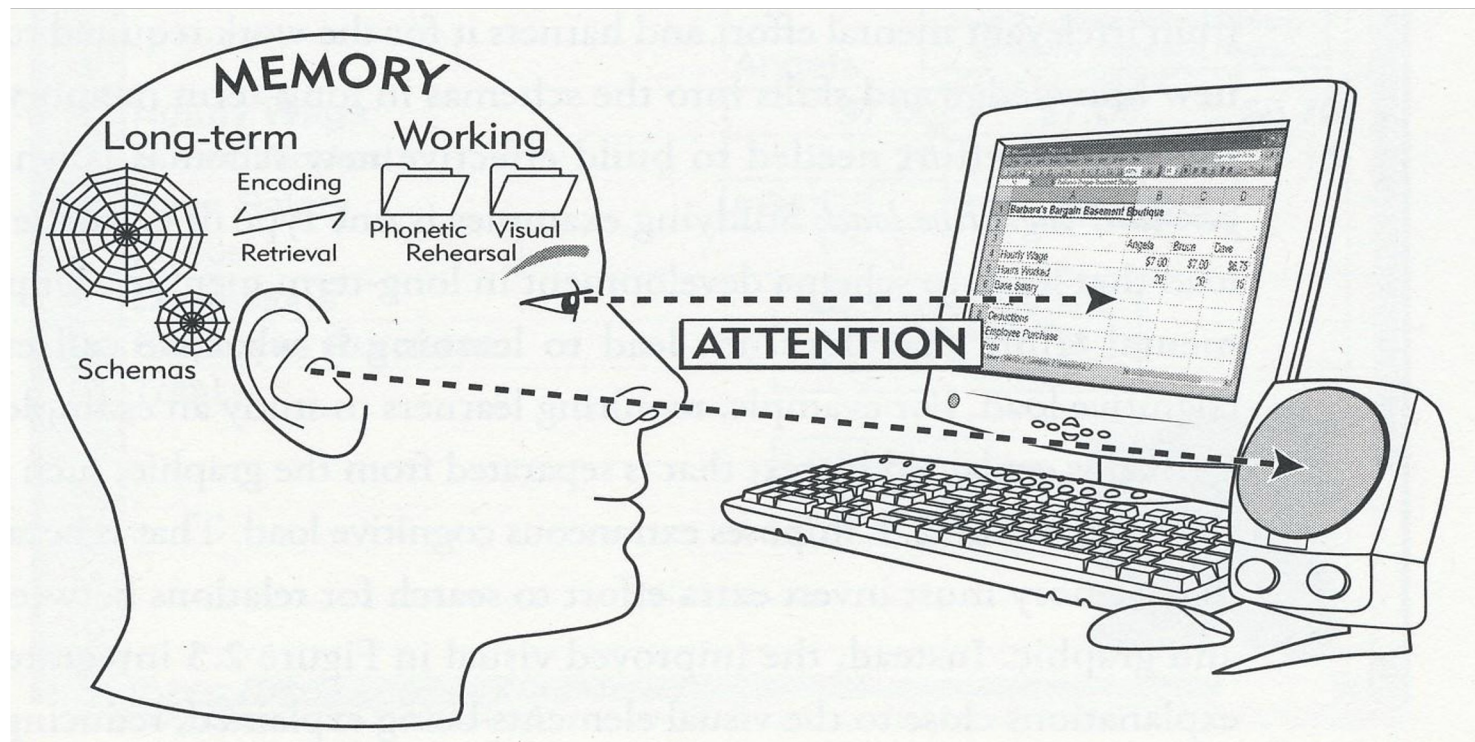
- **Intrinsic cognitive load (I)**
 - load intrinsic to the problem that cannot be reduced without reducing understanding
- **Extraneous cognitive load (E)**
 - a non-intrinsic load caused by instructional procedures that interfere with rather than contribute to learning
- **Germane cognitive load (G)**
 - a non-intrinsic load that contributes to, rather than interfere with, learning by supporting schema acquisition

$$\text{Load } L = I + E + G$$

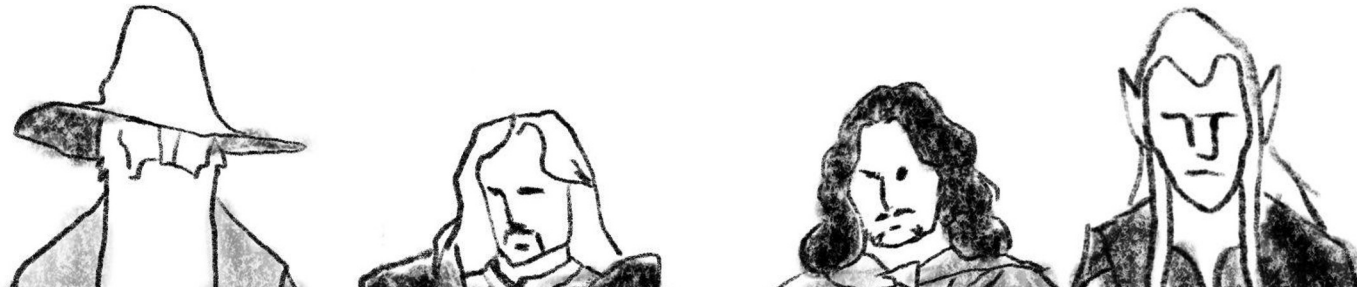


Optimize learning:
minimize E, maximize G

Cognitive Learning Processes



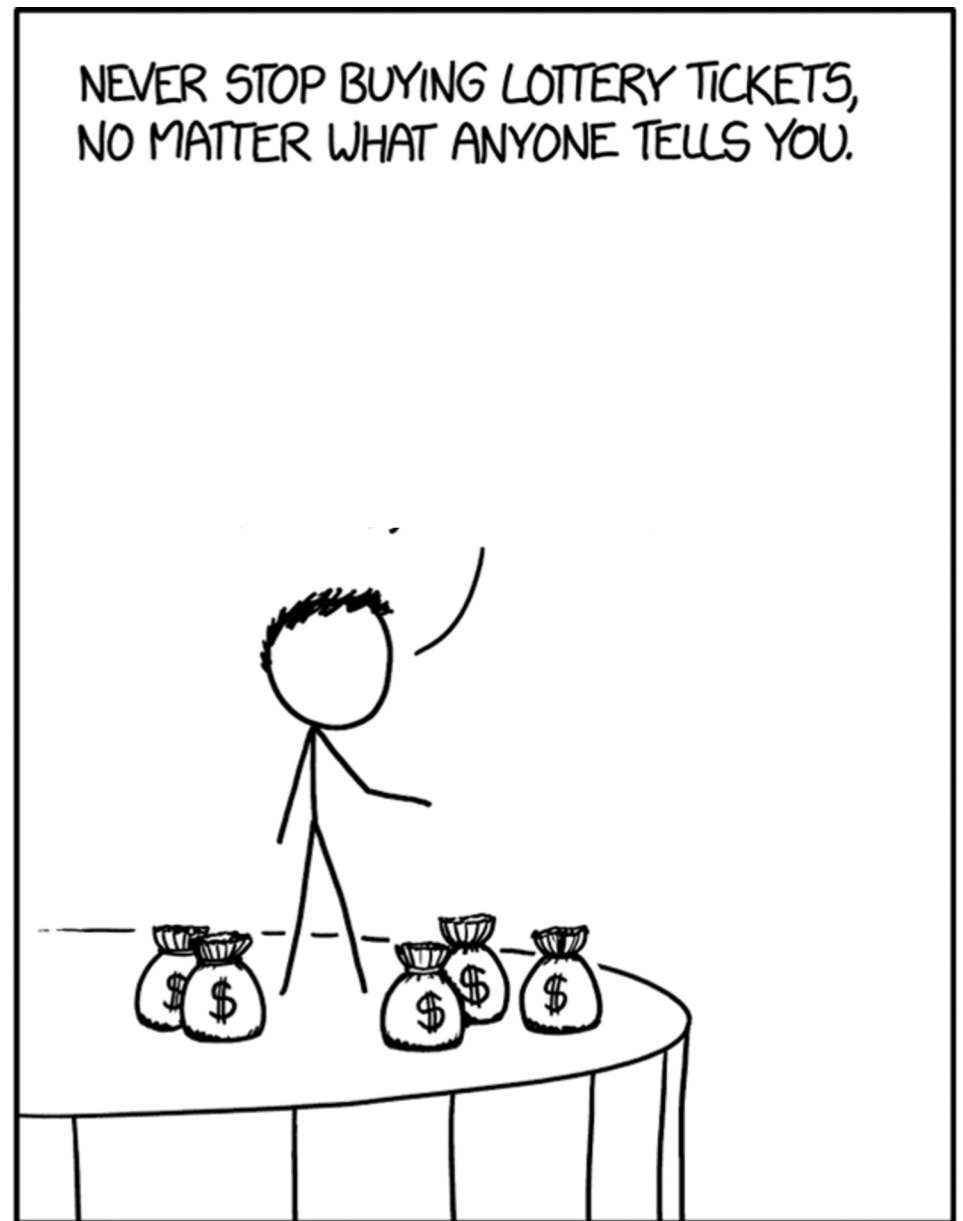

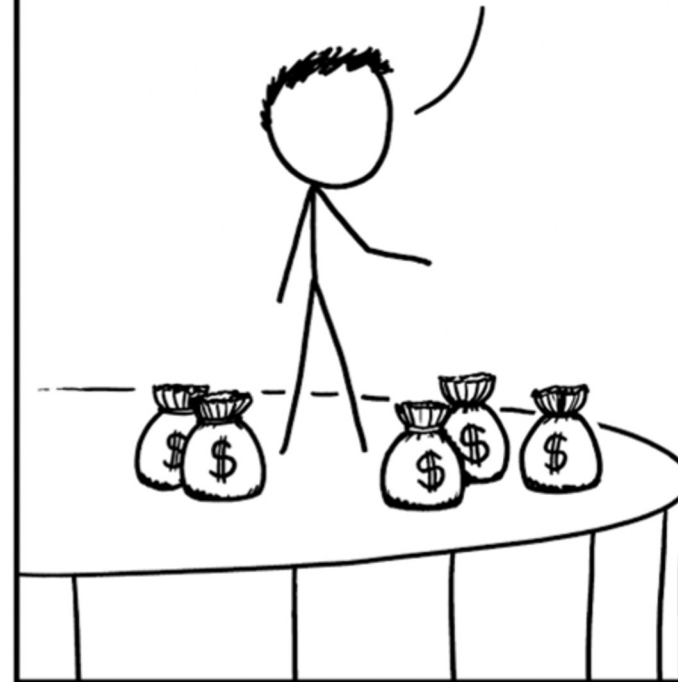

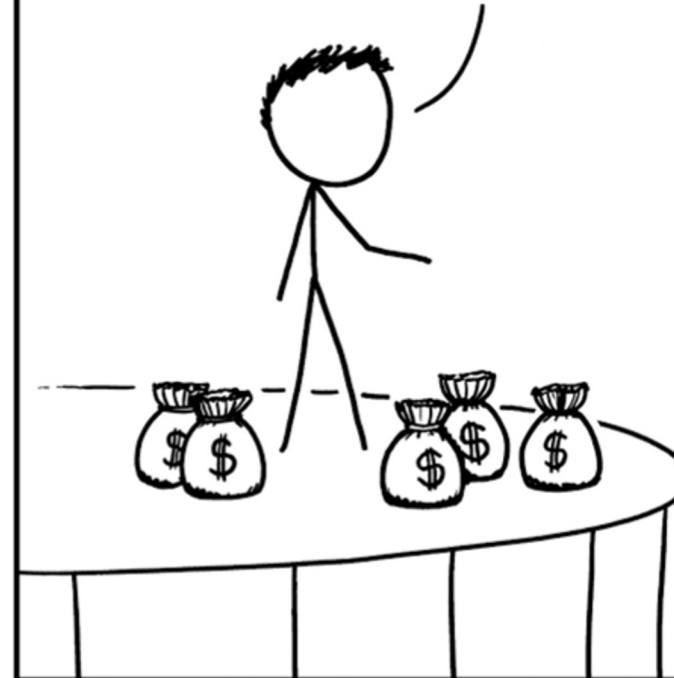
